Are angels real?

- They are involved in your life way more than you realize
- They move between multiple dimensions at the speed of God

That which you can't see is more powerful than that which you can see

- Nowhere in the Bible is any angel ever hurt by any man
- Jacob wrestled, but the angel played

The invisible realm is more powerful and more real than the visible realm

Not believing in the invisible realm reduces our understanding of the ways of God

- Perception then becomes our reality
- The progression from a Hebrew world view to a Latin-Roman world view takes a toll on our thought processes
 - We lose our understanding of the ways of God
 - Acts 12:1-17 The appearance of angels was common in the time of Jesus

There is an amazing similarity between a game of chess and how God uses people

- The movement in the spiritual arena around you is based on your movements
- You are a critical part in God's plan, whether you move around a lot or stay in one place your whole life

- The Beginning and the End

Eternal vs. Everlasting

- Eternal and everlasting are not interchangeable
- Only God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) is eternal
- Eternal means no beginning and no end
- Believing in Jesus gives us everlasting life, not eternal life
- Angels are not eternal, but everlasting beings
- Blurring these lines are the first step to a New Age mentality

New Age believes we are all Gods

- Satan deceived Eve with this lie in the Garden

God placed you at this very moment in history, because there's something only you can do
He chose when and where you should live:

“And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their pre-appointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, ‘For we are also His offspring’” (Acts 17:26–28).
